- Muzzleloader (only open sights allowed, no scopes, 50 cal. minimum for elk)
- Ammo (NO sabots or pelletized powder)

 - Elk (7mm Mag - .30 Caliber Recommended – .300 Win Mag)

 - Elk (165 grain minimum – 180 Recommended)
