

2-Year Genetic HEALTH GUARANTEE

Dogs can be our dearest friends. That's why the unwitting purchase of an unhealthy pet can be so devastating, in an effort to ensure that customers buying a dog in Pennsylvania have a clean bill of health, we offer this health guarantee. The state's dog purchaser protection act states that sellers must provide the buyer with a health record for the dog at the time of sale. The seller shall provide a health certificate issued by a veterinarian within 21 days prior to the date of sale, or a guarantee of good health issued and signed by the seller. To preserve your rights, you must take your newly purchased dog to a licensed veterinarian for examination within 10 days of purchase. If an illness or defect is detected the buyer must notify the seller within 2 business days of the examination, and present to the seller written certification from the vet within 5 days from when the buyer receives it. Failure to do these will result and forfeiture of rights, refunds, or reimbursement. The seller reserves the right to have the condition confirmed by a veterinarian of their choice. Neglecting to take your puppy to a licensed vet within 10 days of purchase will void this guarantee. If a veterinarian determines, within 10 days of purchase, that your dog is critically ill, has died from an injury sustained or illness likely to have been contracted on or before the date of sale, or believes that the puppy is not of sound health, or has a lifethreatening illness you have the following options.

- 1. Return the dog for a complete refund
- 2. Return the dog for a replacement dog of equal value if one is available
- 3. Retain the dog and receive reimbursement for select veterinary fees not exceeding the purchase price of the puppy.

*If the condition can be treated or managed, it is NOT considered a life-threatening condition and is not covered under this guarantee. These options do not apply where a seller who has provided a health certificate issued by a veterinarian discloses in writing at the time of sale a health problem for which the buyer later seeks to return the dog. *Due to biosecurity, there may be times when we cannot physically repossess a puppy!* If within 30 days of purchase a licensed veterinarian determines that the dog has a congenital or hereditary defect which is life-threatening, or that your dog died from a congenital or hereditary defect you have the same options as outlined above. Failure to notify the seller within 2 business days will result in forfeiture of rights, refunds, or reimbursement. Veterinarian certification shall be presented to the seller not later than 5 days after you received it or the guarantee is void.

Registerable dogs: If the seller advertised the dog as registerable and does not provide within a hundred and twenty days of sale all documentation to effect registration you may exercise one of the following options

- 1. Return the dog and receive a full refund of the purchase price
- 2. Retain the dog and receive a 50% refund of the purchase price.

If the puppy dies within 24 months of its birth date from a suspected congenital defect a necropsy (autopsy) must be performed at the buyer's expense by a veterinarian to determine the cause of death. If the necropsy shows a congenital defect as the cause of death the buyer has the following options...

- 1. The puppy will be replaced at no charge to the buyer or
- 2. Full reimbursement of the purchase price of the puppy will be granted.

A written statement from the licensed veterinarian must be provided to the seller within 5 business days of performing the necropsy or this guarantee is void. The buyer assumes all responsibility for any veterinarian bills incurred once the puppy leaves the premises of the breeder. The buyer acknowledges that there is no guarantee on final adult weights, actual size, mature coat or eye color. This guarantee does not cover any veterinarian costs associated with routine medical care of the puppy. Breeding this puppy within 24 months of its birth date will void this guarantee. All puppies are sold as family companions, the seller cannot guarantee the breeding, hunting, or show ability of any puppy. Buyer and Seller both agree to the conditions of the guarantee set forth on this document.
