2023 Soil Health Cost Share:

P23-2744-04; Hendrickx, Michael; is requesting cost share assistance for cover crops on 11.5 acres. This is a one-year multi-species flat rate/acre contract of \$35/acre; cost share payment not to exceed \$402.50 in Rockwood Township, section 28.
