Wadena County met our inspection requirements of 5 inspections in 2024. We completed 6 compliance inspections and 6 manure pit closure inspections this year. All compliance inspections received letters within 30 days of the inspections and were entered into Tempo. All documents for each inspection are located in our Feedlot File Folder as well as uploaded into Tempo under each inspection. We had one producer who needed to update his CSF Permit so SWCD and MPCA staff were able to work with the feedlot owner to get this information updated and the amended CSF Permit was sent to the Feedlot owner. We also had one site with minor non-compliance due to a feed storage area having run off. The feedlot owner was able to correct the problem and was returned to compliance. We also had one manure spill that we responded to that was cleaned up within 24 hours.
